

Community learning disability team

What is the community learning disability team?

We are a team of social workers, community care workers and community nurses working with people over the age of 18 who have a learning disability. We also work with younger people alongside children's services.

What does the team do?

We can carry out an assessment of your needs with you, as well as a separate assessment for your carer, and an assessment of any specialist health care needs.

What happens next?

Provided you qualify for support, we will work with you – and your carer if you have one – to find the right services to help you. We will take into account your wishes and preferences and any cultural and religious needs you may have.

What type of services are available?

Services may include:

- support to live in your own home
- respite care
- help with personal care
