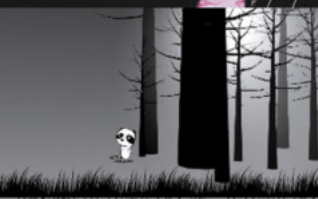
An Evening with Joanna Callaghan
