






# Population by ethnicity

Population of Asian ethnicity in Beech Hill ward accounts for **81.7%** of the population, compared to **37%** in Luton.


The second largest ethnic group is White at **9.2%**, followed by Black ethnicity at **4.0%**.

## Tenure

The most common type of tenure (home ownership or rental, for example) in Beech Hill is owned either outright or with a mortgage/loan at **52.2%**, compared to **54.5%** at Luton average.

The second most commonplace tenure is private rented at **36.6%**, comparing to Luton average at **29.0%**.

## Beech Hill data: overview

The data below shows the figures for Beech Hill, with figures for Luton as a whole in brackets ().

#### Life expectancy

- Female life expectancy at birth: 82.6 years (82.7)
- Male life expectancy at birth: 78.3 years (78.3)
- Overweight or obese children in reception year: **20.6%** (22.6%)
- Overweight or obese children in year 6: 40.8% (41.8%)

#### **Benefits**

- Unemployment benefit JSA and Universal Credit, Jan 2023: 7.2% (5.6%)
- Youth unemployment 18 to 24 receiving JSA or Universal Credit, Jan 2023: 7.2% (6.3%)

#### Employment (Census 2021 data)

- Elementary occupations: **21.5%** (16.9%)
- Process, plant and machine operatives: 16.6% (11.6%)
- Sales and customer service occupations: 10.7% (8.0%)
- Caring, leisure and other service occupations: 10.1% (10.7%)
- Skilled trades occupations: **7.2%** (9.8%)
- Administrative and secretarial occupations: 7.0% (8.5%)
- Associate professional and technical occupations: 7.2% (10.1%)
- Professional occupations: 12.5% (15.8%)
- Managers, directors and senior officials: 7.0% (8.7%)

- People with no qualifications: 31.5% (22.9%)
- Highest level of qualification: level 4/5 degree or higher qualifications: 23.5% (29.8%)
