





Population by ethnicity

Population of White ethnicity in Poets ward accounts for **45.0**% of the population, compared to **45.2**% in Luton.


The second largest ethnic group is Asian at **27.9%**, followed by Black ethnicity at **17.6%**.

Tenure

The most common type of tenure (home ownership or rental, for example) in Poets is owned either outright or with a mortgage/loan at **68.0%**, compared to **54.5%** at Luton average.

The second most commonplace tenure is private rented at 23.0%, comparing to Luton average at 29.0%.

The data below shows the figures for Poets, with figures for Luton as a whole in brackets ().

Life expectancy

- Female life expectancy at birth: 83.2 years (82.7)
- Male life expectancy at birth: 79 years (78.5)
- Overweight or obese children in reception year: 23.4% (22.6%)
- Overweight or obese children in year 6: 42.6% (41.8%)

Benefits

- Unemployment benefit JSA and Universal Credit, Jan 2023: 3.6% (5.6%)
- Youth unemployment 18 to 24 receiving JSA or Universal Credit, Jan 2023: 6.0% (6.3%)

Employment (Census 2021 data)

- Elementary occupations: **14.1%** (14.8%)
- Process, plant and machine operatives: **10.3%** (11.8%)
- Sales and customer service occupations: 7.5% (8.0%)
- Caring, leisure and other service occupations: 9.5% (10.7%)
- Skilled trades occupations: **8.9%** (9.8%)
- Administrative and secretarial occupations: 8.0% (8.5%)
- Associate professional and technical occupations: 9.1% (10.1%)
