## **LUTON IN 2001**

### **Analysis of 2001 Census Data for Luton**

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### Introduction

This paper outlines detailed output from the 2001 Census for Luton. The data are taken from the Standard Tables for Local Authorities, released on 7<sup>th</sup> May 2003, and from the Key Statistics for Local Authorities, released on 13<sup>th</sup> February 2003. Please note that all information presented in this report is Crown copyright data, and is reproduced with the permission of the Controller of HMSO.

It is important to note that the nature of the confidentiality procedures put in place by the Office for National Statistics (ONS) means that figures that are expected to be the same may actually different in different tables. For example, in the very first table in this paper, the total population of Luton is given as 184,371. However, in the first table in the ethnicity section, this total population figure is 184,356. This discrepancy is solely due to random cell adjustment used by the ONS to ensure that individuals cannot be identified. Figures *within* tables, however, do add up to the total figures in that table.

The Research and Intelligence Team understand that this may cause considerable confusion in some instances regarding which figure people should use. As a guideline, for all population figures, those on the Luton Borough Profile should be taken as the correct figures to use, as the data in other tables have been adjusted. Note that only tables that are sourced [Standard Tables for Local Authorities] have been affected by these adjustments.

The Research and Intelligence Team considered not including actual numbers where we felt this would cause unnecessary confusion. However, we have chosen to the publish the figures in order that everyone can have access to them, using this note to qualify the reason for any discrepancies the user may come across. It should be noted that figures have had minimal adjustment throughout, so therefore there are no *significant* differences between the actual figures and the confidentiality adjusted figure.
