

House in multiple occupation (HMO) public notice

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Luton Borough Council hereby gives notice that it has made a designation relating to houses in multiple occupation (HMO) within the borough of Luton.

This designation was made on **24 July 2023**, shall come into force on **30 October 2023** and applies to the whole the borough of Luton. The full designation can be viewed at:

The designation shall be known as The Luton Borough Council Designation of an Area for Additional Licensing of Houses in Multiple Occupation 2023, and requires every premises which is a HMO and situated within the borough of Luton to be licensed unless subject to statutory exemption. Licenses are valid for five years from issue and the designation expires on **29 October 2028**.

The designation does not require confirmation by the Secretary of State as it falls under a general approval issued by the secretary of state under section 58 of the act, namely The Housing Act 2004: Licensing of Houses in Multiple Occupation and Selective licensing of Other Residential Accommodation (England) General Approval 2015 ('the General Approval').

HMOs which are housing five or more persons already require a licence under the Housing Act 2004.

Under the designation coming into effect on 30th October 2023 any person having control of or managing a licensable property without a licence shall be guilty of an offence under Section 72 (1) of the act, and shall be liable to prosecution and upon summary conviction liable to a fine of any amount.

A person who breaches a condition of a licence is liable to prosecution and upon summary conviction liable to a fine of any amount. Furthermore, Housing Benefit payments may be recovered by way of a rent repayment order as set out in section 73(5) and (6) and section 74 of the Housing Act 2004.
