I began my career with Hayward Tyler in January 2005 as a Foreman in the Machine Shop. At the time there were three Foreman responsible for specific areas of the Shop Floor. My responsibility was the Heavy Machine Shop.

In 2008 the Shop Floor was re-organised and I was promoted to Shift Manager. Working a two shift pattern I was responsible for all Shop Floor related activities while on shift.

2010 saw the three internal business units merge into one. The position arose for a Material Control Manager and I successfully applied for the post. This role involved managing and developing a team to streamline all the varying procedures into one company process.

In 2011 the business understood the need to create a global Schedule for our organisation and over the next three years this was developed. This provided me with the opportunity to develop further into the role of Master Scheduler and resulted in me being responsible for scheduling all Manufacturing aspects of our business.

Due to the success of the manufacturing schedule, in 2014 the decision was made to expand the scheduling throughout the business to encompass the Engineering and Applications Departments, scheduling not only real orders from order receipt to shipping but also provisioning capacity and understanding future load for pipeline bids and enquiries. From 2014 to present I hold the position of Scheduling Manager.
