Definitive Map and Statement for the Excluded Fully Developed Area of Luton

Luton Borough Council, Footpath reference LO75 (39 & 41 Stanmore Crescent to 35 & 37 Icknield Road, Luton) Definitive Map and Statement Modification Order 2023

The above Order made on 27th February 2023, if confirmed as made, will modify the definitive map and statement for the excluded fully developed area of Luton by adding to them the following length of footpath as described in the full Order and summarised below:

The length of Footpath reference LO75 to be added extends from the side of 39 & 41 Stanmore Crescent, Luton at Ordnance Survey map grid reference E506825 N223846 (Point A on the Order map) travelling in a south easterly direction for approximately 80 metres to a point by the side of 35 & 37 Icknield Road, Luton at Ordnance Survey Grid Reference E506881 N223789 (Point B on the Order map).

The Footpath varies in width between 3.0 meters and 2.7metres approximately.

A copy of the Order and its map is available to view free of charge at any time on the public notice board by the Upper George Street entrance to the Town Hall, Luton LU1 2BQ and to the right of the reception desk on the ground floor in the Town Hall, Luton - Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday between 8.30 am and 5pm (Weds 10am-5pm). The Order and map may be purchased from Luton Borough Council at a charge of £4.00 by contacting 01582 547178 between 9am - 4pm.

An explanatory statement is also displayed at these locations which explains why the order has been made. THIS STATEMENT DOES NOT FORM PART OF THE ORDER.

Any representation or objection relating to this Order must be sent in writing to the Highways Asset Manager, Highways Services, Luton Borough Council Building 14 Kingsway Depot, Kingsway, Luton LU4 8AU no later than 21st April 2023 and applicants are required to state the grounds on which it is made. Representations and objections must include either a postal or e-mail address. Any representations or objections made will be in the public domain and will be available for viewing/copying by members of the public.

If no such representations or objections are duly made, or if any so made are withdrawn, the Luton Borough Council may itself confirm the Order. If the Order is submitted to the Secretary of State for the Environment, Food and Rural Affairs for confirmation, any representations and objections which have not been withdrawn will be sent with it.
