### **VARIATION TO THE EAST OF ENGLAND PERMIT SCHEME**

The Traffic Management Act Permit Scheme (England) (Amendment) Regulations, *Statutory Instrument 2015 No. 958*, came into force on 30<sup>th</sup> June 2015 and all local highway authorities need to be compliant with these Regulations by 1<sup>st</sup> October 2015.

In order to comply with these regulations the East of England Permit Scheme Permit Authorities, *which comprise Hertfordshire County Council, Bedford Borough Council, Luton Borough Council and Southend-on-Sea Borough Council*, have made changes to the East of England Permit Scheme, *referred to as the Permit Scheme*. This revised version of the Permit Scheme (1.3) will replace the current version in effect (1.2).

Luton Borough Council has exercised its powers conferred by Section 33A (2) of the Traffic Management Act 2004 and made an Order to bring the revised Permit Scheme into effect on 28<sup>th</sup> September 2015. This Order was made on 27<sup>th</sup> August 2015 and can be found at [Luton.gov.uk/Transport\\_and\\_Streets/Streetworks](http://Luton.gov.uk/Transport_and_Streets/Streetworks).

As required by Regulation 17(1) of The Traffic Management Permit Scheme (England) (Amendment) Regulations 2007, I hereby inform you that the revised Permit Scheme (version 1.3) will come into effect on **28<sup>th</sup> September 2015**.
