NOTICE OF APPLICATION FOR LICENCE

We Luton International Carnival **Of** Luton Carnival Arts Development Trust are applying for the Grant of a Premises Licence for Luton Carnival to include; Church Street (the whole length including pavements), Park Street (from its junction with Church Street to its junction with Vicarage Street including pavements), Park Street West (the whole length including pavements), Flowers Way (the whole length including pavements), Castle Street (the whole length including pavements), George Street (the whole length including pavements), Manchester Street (the whole length including pavements), New Bedford Road (from its junction with Manchester Street to its junction with Stockingstone Road) & Wardown Park.

If granted, the licence will enable the following to take place:
The provision of regulated entertainment consisting of live music, recorded music, performances of dance and anything of a similar description to live music, recorded music or performances of dance on between the hours of 12:00 and 18:15 on Sundays for an event known as Luton International Carnival (or similar title)
