NOTICE OF APPLICATION FOR LICENCE**

Are applying for the Grant of a Premises Licence
If granted, the licence will enable the following to take place:

Provision of live music – Monday to Saturday (to take place indoors only), between the hours of 11:00 to 04:00 (the following day) and Sundays, between the hours of 11:00 to 23:00

Provision of recorded music – Monday to Saturday (to take place indoors only), between the hours of 11:00 to 04:00 (the following day) and Sundays, between the hours of 11:00 to 23:00

Provision of anything of a similar description to live music, recorded music or performances of dance – Monday to Saturday (to take place indoors only), between the hours of 11:00 to 04:00 (the following day) and Sundays, between the hours of 11:00 to 23:00

Late night refreshment – Monday to Saturday (to take place indoors only), between the hours of 23:00 to 04:00 (the following day)

Supply of alcohol – Monday to Saturday (for consumption on the premises only) and Sundays, between the hours of 11:00 to 23:00

State any seasonal variation:

The premises may open later during special events with closing times extended by an hour on such occasion only and we will ensure all events comply with the council licensing policies including measures to control noise and manage guest behaviour to minimize the impact on the local area.

Non-Standard Timings for supply of alcohol as requested:

On special occasions such as Christmas Eve, New Years' Eve, the premises may remain open not more than an hour beyond the licensed hours. These occasions will be limited to a few times per year and managed with appropriate noise control and security.
